All attendees: Respectful Communication

Please speak and act respectfully toward DSST staff, Coliseum staff, and fellow attendees. Cussing, harassment, discriminatory language, and physical intimidation are not allowed.

- **Student Expectations:** Students are expected to follow directions from their advisors, school leaders, and event staff. Students who do not follow these expectations will receive school-based consequences. In rare cases, we may ask families to step in and support.
- **Senior Family Expectations:** Family members and guests who are unable to meet these expectations may be asked to leave the event.

All attendees: Responsibility for Safety

Everyone plays a role in keeping this event safe.

- **Drugs, alcohol, and nicotine products (including vapes and wax pens) are prohibited** at the Coliseum.
 - Students in violation will face school-based consequences.
 - Families may be asked to leave, and, if needed, law enforcement will be involved.
- **Weapons and physical altercations are strictly prohibited.** Law enforcement will be involved in any serious safety concerns, and school consequences will apply.
